DAY OF PROCEDURE

- 1. Please bathe or shower prior to your procedure. Do not use lotions or oils after bathing.
- 2. Wear loose, comfortable clothing such as sweat suits and easy to button shirts or blouses. Wear comfortable shoes.
- 3. Leave valuables, including jewelry and cash at home. We will not be responsible for damaged to lost property.
- 4. Be prepared to sign a form giving your consent for the procedure. If the patient is under 18, a parent or legal guardian must accompany the patient and sign the consent form.
- 5. Items to bring with you include but are not limited to containers for eye wear, medical equipment (O2 tank), and any important records such as living will or patient advocate forms.
- 6. Bring all insurance cards and a photo I.D.
- 7. Please arrive promptly for your scheduled appointment. The time given to you is your check-in time, not your procedure time.
- 8. Instructions for your care after your procedure will be given to you at the time of your discharge.
- 9. You will be closely monitored throughout your stay for your safety and comfort.
